Confessions of a Not-so-confident Coach

set out to become a coach with a fair amount of confidence, but in the early part of my journey I almost talked myself out of it. When I transitioned from marketing into coaching, I didn't know exactly what to expect. Coaching was unfamiliar territory. Like anyone starting something new I had doubts. Was I ready? Could I manage such a big change? Did I know enough?

At first my biggest struggle was confidence; or rather the lack of it. Every coaching session felt like an exam. I worried about how I appeared, whether my clients felt genuinely helped and when I'd finally feel comfortable calling myself a coach. Choosing a niche felt equally puzzling. I often asked myself how other coaches made such decisions or if it was even necessary. I remember once staring at the Zoom screen before a session, heart racing and wondering if I should postpone.

Reflecting on those early uncertain days, these are the shifts that slowly made coaching feel more real for me: I learned that genuine coaching presence doesn't develop overnight. It comes slowly – one session at a time through patience and gentle persistence. Observing experienced coaches within our ICF community showed me that true presence is built quietly with practice and self-compassion.

Another important realisation was around finding a niche. Initially, I believed having a clear specialisation right away

was essential. But interacting with fellow ICF coaches helped me realise it's perfectly fine not to rush this. Coach first; let clarity arrive naturally.

Most importantly, I discovered the real confidence booster wasn't just books or coaching techniques. It came from interactions and engagement with other coaches – listening, sharing experiences, learning, and feeling genuinely supported and encouraged by the community. Today I'm still learning and growing yet feeling steadier with each step.

The shift for me happened through showing up, not chasing, and leaning into the coaches' community around me. Even now, when I find myself in a similar space, I remind myself gently: Take that step, trust the process, and connect; even if you're not so confident. That, in itself, is coaching. It has been just a year since I became part of the ICF Mumbai Chapter and at the in-person Chapter anniversary event 'Beyond 10' in April 2025 something felt different. I felt like I belonged. For someone who came in with more questions than answers, this is it ■



- 4. All conversation should be meaningful, well directed and thought-provoking
- 5. To create new thinking, wear your Coaching Hat so that the inherent obstacles or infirmities are addressed and self-analysed for desirable solutions.
- Finally, the importance of follow-up should not be overlooked so that the thinking instigated does not loose fizz, and all aspects of feelings are well respected.
